Padre's Ponderings

I invite you, therefore, in the name of the Church,
to the observance of a holy lent,
by self-examination and repentance;
by prayer, fasting, and self-denial;
and by reading and meditating on God's Holy word ..."

Thus, this is the invitation on Ash Wednesday that is extended to all of us as we begin the great season of Lent. Recently, Lent has become famous for "What are you giving up for Lent this year?" instead of "What are you taking on for the season of Lent?" If one looks closely at the invitation above, the majority of the invitation is inviting us to take on something as our observance of Lent. Yes, fasting and self-denial are encouraged but this is only two-sevenths of the invitation.

As your Parish Priest and Spiritual Leader, I would like to challenge you to make a plan to "take on" a discipline to make Lent holy and meaningful. Let me give you some ideas:

Ash Wednesday Worship service: there will be three services on Feb. 18th to choose from—7:30 am, 12 noon and 7:00 pm—with all three being offered in the Church this year.

Parents: children are invited to begin to observe Lent the correct way.

<u>Mid-Week Worship services:</u> every Wednesday at 7:30am and 12:10pm a shortened Eucharist service is offered with the Laying-on-of-Hands for healing at the 12:10 service. These services are held in Adams Chapel in the Office Building.

<u>Friday Stations-of-the Cross:</u> at 5:30pm on Fridays the spiritual discipline of Stations is offered in the Nave of the Church.

<u>Adult Education:</u> on Sundays at 9:15am in the Conference Room. The subject is "24 Hours—The Final Hours of Jesus' Life"

<u>Wednesday Night Lenten Supper and Study Time:</u> at 6:30 we will gather in Trinity Hall for a covered dish meal followed by a time of study or teaching. At this time, the subject matter has not been finalized. This will run from the Wednesday after Ash Wednesday, February 25th through the week prior to Holy Week.

the season of LENT

Lent 2015 is to be a time of adding discipline into our lives. Fasting and self-denial can still be a part of your Lent observances if you desire. But the idea of taking on something new to increase our discipline and knowledge is encouraged. As creative people you can surely come up with other ideas of ways to draw closer to the Holy Spirit during this season of self-reflection and study.

One final suggestion: How about keeping a Journal and write in it everyday of Lent. These Journal entries can be simple or as complex as you desire. Ask yourself,

"What was my closest moment to Christ today?"

"Where did I observe God today?"

"God, I ask you for _____?"

(you fill in the blank and why)

I pray you have a holy Lent and a meaningful one as well. During the Easter season, I will be asking you to share what you did and how did you grow spiritually.

When we labor and are laden with worries and cares,
Refresh us, O Christ.
When our hands are not ready to accept help,
Renew our trust, O Christ.
When we grow weary of loving others,
Love us, O Christ.
As we lift our hopes and joys to you,
Hear us, O Christ. Amen.

Dan Thomas, Junior Warden and Michael Rauh, Senior Warden.




LENTEN DINNER SERIES
