BLESSING OF THE LAND

Join us for a Rogation Week **Blessing of the Land** on Saturday, **May 16 at 1:00 pm** at the Curry Farm, 2277 Winding Road, Parkersburg. Rogation Days were traditionally observed the three weekdays before the Feast of the Ascension. In more recent years, they have been observed on other days, depending on local conditions and the convenience of the congregation. Anciently, the observance consisted of an outdoor procession which culminated in a special celebration of the Eucharist. In late medieval England, congregations would gather to “beat the bounds” of the parish, walking in procession around the geographical extremities of the parish’s locality, praying for God’s blessing on agriculture.
